Fr. Marcos Gonzalez, pastor of St. Andrew Parish in Pasadena, was the founding chaplain and spiritual director for St. Monica Academy. He holds an additional MS in Ecclesial Administration and Management (MBA for church entities) from the Catholic University of America in Washington. In addition to parish ministry, he has served on the boards of a variety of organizations including Catholic Engaged Encounter and the California Association of Natural Family Planning and as chaplain to various Catholic Cuban organizations. He is a Knight Commander in the Order of the Holy Sepulchre and has been a Knight of Columbus since he was 18 years old.
