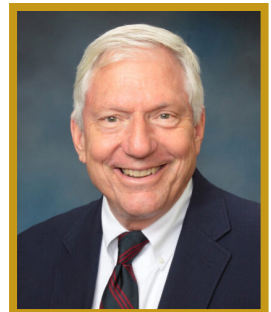

As we celebrate both the 25th Anniversary of St. Monica Academy and the 250th Anniversary of the United States of America, we welcome the return of Martin Boles, an SMA founder, beloved faculty member, and former board president. A teacher of U.S. History and a perennial Speaker Series favorite, Mr. Boles has debunked numerous calumnies in American history in his past talks. Tonight, he will review how knowledge of history, logic, mathematics, science, and rhetoric affected events in our country's history through the educational preparation, decision-making, and speeches of historical actors.

Martin Boles was a founding parent of St. Monica Academy and served on SMA's board for 15 years. He has now serves as headmaster of The Camino School, a classical Christian school in Orange County founded by his daughter, SMA alumna Molly Boles Rose. Mr. Boles spent 34 years in the Litigation Department at the law firm of Kirkland & Ellis, successfully defending British Petroleum in the Deepwater Horizon litigation among numerous other cases. He graduated Phi Beta Kappa and Summa Cum Laude from Dartmouth College and received his JD and MBA degrees from Stanford. He and his wife Julia have 9 children, all of whom attended St. Monica Academy.
