Almost everything I've written about abortion has been im-
personal and philosophical. But tonight, I want to talk about
the ways I believe God protected me, guided me, and shaped
me through the workings of his providence and the graced
choices of other people. I tell these stories in hopes that they
might inspire others to see the hand of God in their own lives
and inspire them to protect human life.



Dr. Christopher Kaczor is President of the American Philosophical Association, Professor of Philosophy at Loyola Marymount, and appointed Visiting Faculty Affiliate at Harvard. He graduated from the Honors Program of Boston College and earned a Ph.D. four years later from the University of Notre Dame. A Fulbright Scholar, Dr. Kaczor is also a former Federal Chancellor Fellow at the University of Cologne, Honorary Professor in Bishop Barron's Word on Fire Institute, and William E. Simon Visiting Fellow at Princeton. His books include *Is Belief Believable?*; *The Gospel of Happiness*, *The Seven Big Myths about Marriage*, *A Defense of Dignity*, *The Seven Big Myths about the Catholic Church*, *The Ethics of Abortion*, *Thomas Aquinas on the Cardinal Virtues*; *Life Issues-Medical Choices*, *Thomas Aquinas on Faith, Hope, and Love*; and *Proportionalism and the Natural Law Tradition*. Dr. Kaczor's views have been in *The New York Times*, *The Washington Post*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *The Los Angeles Times*, *Huffington Post*, *National Review*, *NPR*, *BBC*, *EWTN*, *ABC*, *NBC*, *FOX*, *CBS*, *MSNBC*, *TEDx*, and *The Today Show*.
